This letter is in further response to your correspondence of June 17, 1974 regarding the reestablishment of brown trout in the East Fork of the Russian River above Lake Mendocino.

Approximately 10,000 Shasta strain brown trout fingerlings have recently become available to us. Final arrangements are currently being made to plant them in Potter Valley before the end of August, 1974. A viable population of brown trout is expected to become established as a result of this introduction.
