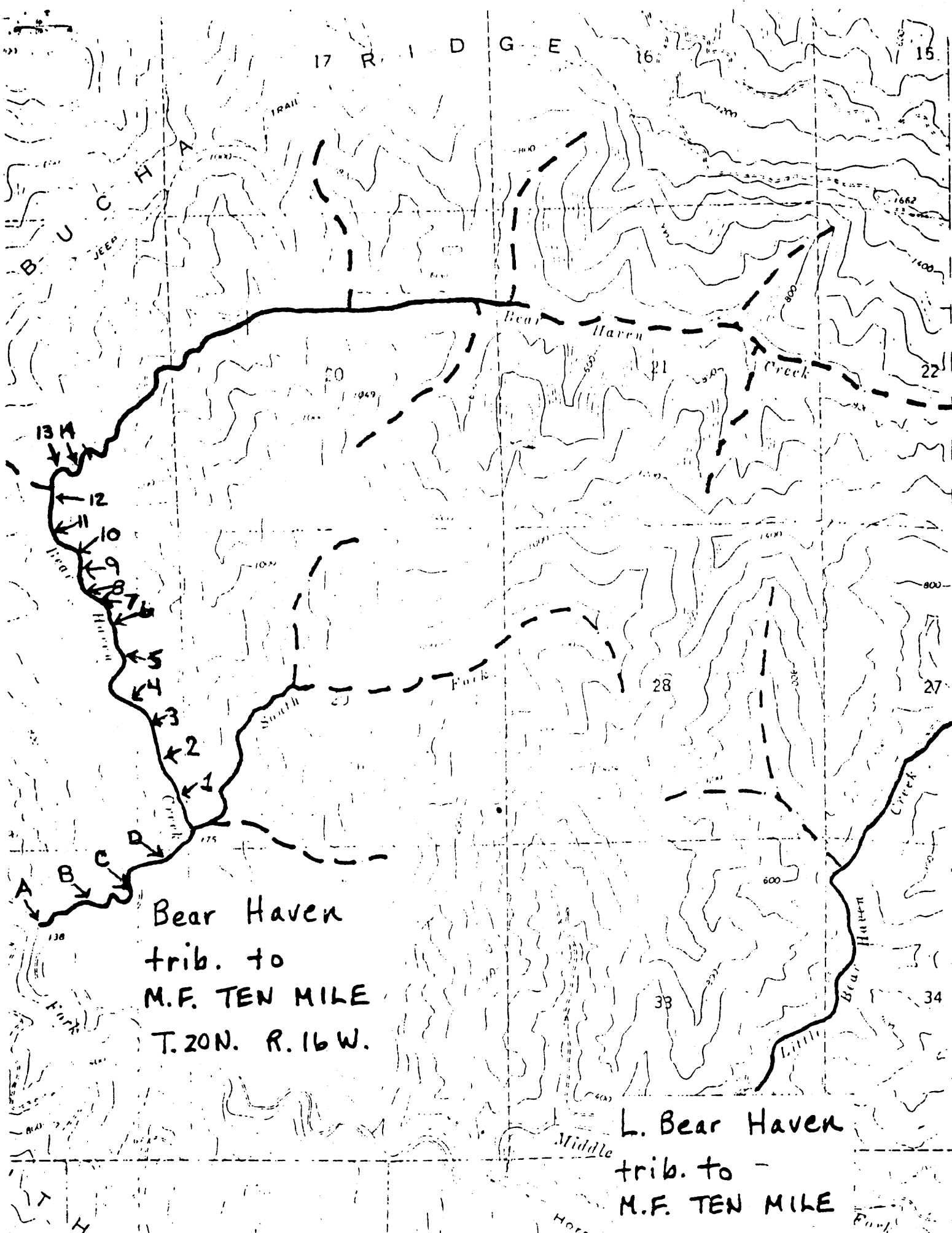
Further action recommended Upper 1/2 should be worked on -up to 50 jams have been identified. South Fork of Bear Haven is a good spawning tributary.

**Extensive bank stabilization work was done to save logging road being undercut by stream diverted by jam.**
